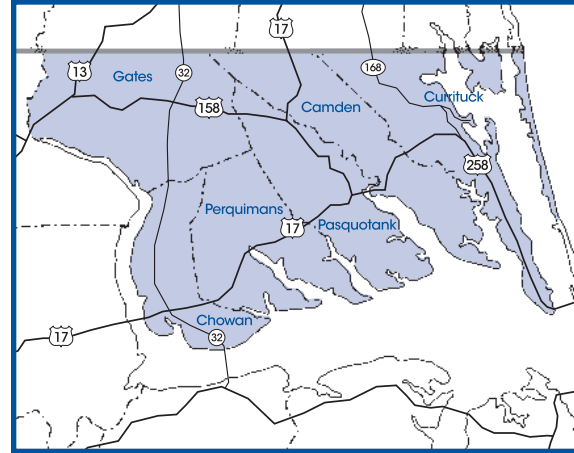

Participants may be dropped off by family members, or transportation can be arranged.

CAP Case Management

Albemarle Home Care serves as the lead agency for the Community Alternatives Program for Disabled Adults (CAP-DA) and for Children (CAP-C) for Camden, Currituck, Pasquotank, and Perquimans counties. These programs are designed to assist disabled individuals to remain in their homes — and out of nursing homes and other institutions — for as long as possible.

Eligibility and Payment

For a patient to qualify for Albemarle Home Care programs, the services must be ordered by a physician. We work with each patient's physician, family, and other caregivers to develop a plan of care that meets each patient's needs.

Albemarle Home Care services are usually covered by Medicaid, Medicare, and most insurance plans. We also accept patients without insurance, and will discuss financial arrangements for private payment. Our services are easy to arrange, and convenient for patients and their families.
